

CAUTION SHEET FOR GP-31/GP-36

The importance of a thorough installation cannot be overemphasized. Without a thorough installation optimum performance cannot be expected. Please follow the guidelines below when installing the equipment.

Antenna Cable, Antenna Unit (Chapter 9)



- 1) DO NOT CUT THE ANTENNA CABLE!
- ② To pass the antenna cable through a hole which is not large enough to pass the connector, you may unfasten the connector with a needle nose pliers and 3/8-inch openend wrench. Refasten it as shown below, after running the cable through the hole.




- 3 Short the pin and shield (connector housing) to prevent damage to the antenna unit.
- Fasten the pipe to the antenna unit by turning the pipe; not the antenna. Fastening by turning the antenna unit will cause cable twist and plate stress on the connector.

Connection to a PC (page 7-10)

Your equipment provides a wiring diagram which shows how to connect the equipment to a PC, with a DSUB 9-pin connector (EIA-574). You may display the diagram as follows:

- 1. Press the [MENU] key once or twice to open the menu.
- 2. Select I/O SETUP with the cursor pad and press the [ENT] key.
- 3. Select WIRING INFO with the cursor pad and press the [ENT] key to display the wiring info display.



Note: This diagram shows the connection with a DSUB 9-pin connector. For the connection with a DSUB 25-pin connector, see page 7-10.
